Over 400 people attended "Heartland's Night at the Bandshell," our most recent 30th Anniversary event. The concert (at Ames' Bandshell Park) featured the Heartland Senior Band (under the direction of Don Dobell), the Songbird Chorus, and three performers from HSS's Variety Show: Jim Maden, and Bob and Marilyn Curry. KASI Radio's Mel Crippen served as Master of Ceremonies for the event. The concert was a celebration of HSS's 30 years of service and a thank you to the supporters of HSS.

The band performed a number of songs, including a patriotic medley and a moving tribute to the veterans in the audience. Just prior to the concert, Marion Willoughby distributed heart-shaped balloons to the audience. Free cookies were also given out, courtesy of Cub Foods, Dutch Oven Bakery, and Hy-Vee West. Sam's Club donated bottled water, which was sold to the audience as a fundraiser.
